A securities registration statement regarding this disposal of treasury shares has been filed pursuant to the Financial Instruments and Exchange Act.

2. Purpose and reasons for disposal

The Company revised the directors' compensation system at the Board of Directors' meeting held on May 12, 2017 mainly by abolishing the system of directors' retirement benefits, adopting a new compensation system and reducing the maximum amount of compensation under the existing system. In the course of this revision, it resolved to introduce a restricted stock compensation plan (hereinafter, the "Plan") as a new compensation system for Directors of the Company (excluding Outside Directors and Directors who are Audit & Supervisory Committee Members; hereinafter, "Eligible Directors") and Directors of the Company's subsidiaries (together with the Eligible Directors; hereinafter, collectively "Eligible Directors, etc.") for the purpose of granting medium- to long-term incentives to and sharing shareholder value with the Eligible Directors, etc. Subsequently, the Company received approval to pay Eligible Directors a maximum of 100,000,000 yen per year as monetary compensation receivables as contributed property for acquisition of the restricted stock (hereinafter, "restricted stock compensation"), based on the Plan, at the 14th Ordinary General

Shareholders' Meeting held on June 23, 2017, and to set the transfer restriction period of the restricted stock between three to six years, as determined by the Board of Directors.
